travel allowances to attend international conferences

The aim of this measure of the GGG is to enable Ph.D. students to further specialize on their thesis subject by participating in international conferences and enhancing their key skills.

The program supporting the attendance of international conferences is only applicable to Ph.D. students of the five member faculties (Faculty of Law, Faculty of Social Sciences, Faculty of Economic Sciences, Department for Agricultural Economics and Rural Development, Faculty of Forestry (economical, political and environmental professorships). Ph.D. students of study programs affiliated to the GGG may also apply.

Precondition for the allowance is either a presentation or a poster, which needs to be prepared for the conference or workshop. A short report and the reception form must be sent to the KMU-Netzwerk after the participation. As the funding period will come to an end, all allowances will need to have been claimed by 31 Nov 2012; all account and transfer details with the GGG will need to have been settled by 15 Dec 2012.
