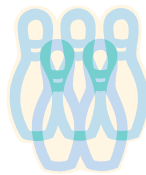
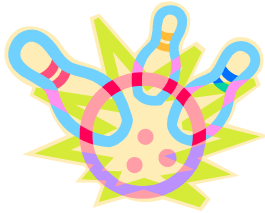

City trip to Hameln, May 19th

Again, it is time for a city trip. This time we will go to Hameln. Who has not heard of the famous Pied Pieper of Hameln? So let's visit the city, where this famous story has its origin. It is said that more than 1 billion people know this fairy tale. Furthermore, Hameln also offers a nice old city with many beautiful half-timbered and stone houses and an atmospheric marketplace.

The day is planned as follows: We will go to Hameln with the train at 11.07 am, what takes about one and half hour. We will then have a guided city tour of 90 minutes that leads us to all important places. Afterwards, we have about two hours spare time left where we can go for an ice-cream, do some shopping in the city or have a further look at the sights. My plan is to take the train back to Göttingen at 5.28 pm, so that we arrive in Göttingen at 7 pm (if somebody wants to leave earlier, there is also a train connection at 3.28 pm which means arriving at 5 pm.).

If you want to participate, please send me an email until May 12th. The costs will be 2 € per person if you have the Semesterticket. If you do not have it, you have to buy the train ticket yourself (please tell me, then we can find the best solution for you).
