



### **3 Steps to enrol in a Master study programme**

#### **1. Declaration of acceptance**

Please declare acceptance of the place via the online form "Master - additional data".  
(<https://immatrikulation.zvw.uni-goettingen.de/masterergaenzung/index.php>) by  
**October 24th 2018 at the latest.**

#### **2. Matriculation**

The matriculation is to be carried out using the online form "Master - additional data" (<https://immatrikulation.zvw.uni-goettingen.de/masterergaenzung/index.php>). Please follow the instructions and upload all required documents by **October 24th 2018 at the latest**. Please submit the semester fees by stating your applicant number ("Bewerbernummer" stated in the admission letter).

Please also submit the required written declaration of acceptance as well as the affidavit declaration to **Registrar's Office** (Wilhelmsplatz 4, 37073 Göttingen) via post.

#### **3. Diploma/Certificate:**

In case you could not send your diploma of your previous study programme when applying, please upload (<https://upload.uni-goettingen.de/portal/portal.php?lang=en>) it by **November 15<sup>th</sup> 2018 at the latest**. **Please note** that in exceptional cases and under certain conditions, **the deadline can be extended** by the end of your first Master semester (**March 31<sup>st</sup> 2019**). The deadline extension is only possible if:  
**a)** the Bachelor thesis is the only missing examination result  
or **b)** the Bachelor thesis has already been submitted and passed and maximum 8 credits are still outstanding for the examination.

In both cases you have to prove that this is the case with an explanatory letter of your examinations office by **November 15<sup>th</sup> 2018**. The letter has to be submitted to the Office of the Dean of Studies.
