Language(s) of instruction

Approx. 60 courses taught in English are offered at the Faculty per semester

Language(s) requirements

At least fluent in English (level B2), some German is beneficial

Application deadline

Winter semester (Oct-Jan): June 1st

Summer semester (April-July): December 1st

Application procedure

1) Coordinator of the home university sends out the nomination to Berit Sellmer (incoming@wiwi.uni-goettingen.de).



- 2) Berit Sellmer gets back to the coordinator and forward the nominations to the international office of University of Göttingen.

- Official transcript of records

- Proof of valid health insurance (European Health Insurance Card) for students from non-EU countries. -> This document will be required during enrollment.

Most of the final exams will take place during the three weeks following the lecture period (some courses may offer exams already during the lecture period in order to meet the international academic calendar).

What types of courses are offered?

Students can choose between:

- 1) lectures (sometimes complemented with a tutorial/practice session)
- 2) seminars.

Lectures involve that students have to attend the course on a weekly basis, either 1.5 or 3 hours per week and take a (mostly written) exam at the end of the semester.

A seminar does mostly not involve presence teaching but a preparatory meeting at the beginning of the semester where each student is assigned to a topic to write a paper on (10-15 pages) independently under the teacher's supervision. At the end of the seminar all papers are presented and discussed and participants are graded based upon their paper, presentation, and participation in the seminar (discussion of other participants' papers).

Do students have to be pre-enrolled or pre-registered?

For lectures there is no registration required. However, if students wish to participate in seminars, a registration is often necessary. So please check the course descriptions before you arrive in Göttingen.

Every course (lecture or seminar) passed is awarded with 6 ECTS. We recommend all our regularly enrolled and exchange students to choose
