**Dorothea Schlözer-Program**  
**CAREER COACHING FOR FEMALE POSTDOCS**  
**NEW CALL 2019**

You are a female postdoc at Göttingen University or at the Göttingen Campus and aim at a leading position in science?

The Dorothea Schlözer career coaching for postdocs will promote your career development and will prepare you for a (international) leading role in research and academia. The one-year intensive program provides training and coaching in key academic skills as well as practical career-relevant knowledge relating to international science management, research funding, leadership skills, appointment procedures and networking for female scientists and scholars of different disciplines.

The program enhances career development in a flexible and individual manner: It combines a wide range of methods (individual and group coaching, workshops and trainings) as well as information and networking options with advisors from inside and outside Göttingen University.

**Target group**

The program is open for all female postdocs, leaders of junior research groups and junior professors at Göttingen University and the Göttingen Campus.

**Requirements**

Active participation is compulsory. Furthermore, your supervisor supports your participation in the program and will release you from work on these days.

The program will start with an obligatory **kick-off workshop** on **March 12, 2019**. Before the kick-off workshop, we will already have a **first acquaintance** together with participants of the Dorothea Schlözer mentoring program on **February 28th, 2019**. There you can already network with other scientists.

The workshops are free of charge. The costs incurred for materials, drinks and refreshments during the workshops amount of **80 Euros** per person, which are to be paid in advance.

Please note: The courses will be offered bilingual if possible (German/ English, dependent on the language skills of the participants). However, basic knowledge of both languages is required and a prerequisite for some of the workshops. The training material is in German.

**Application**

1. Letter setting out your motivation for participation and stating your envisaged future career
2. Brief description of your current research project with information on the state of your work
3. Curriculum vitae including a list of publications
