Introduction

STORMA (Stability of Rainforest Margins) is comprehensive interdisciplinary research collaboration between the Georg-August-University of Goettingen and the University of Kassel in Germany and the Bogor Agricultural University (IPB) and the Tadulako University Palu in Indonesia.

The research activities of STORMA were launched in 2000 in the vicinity of the Lore Lindu National Park in Central Sulawesi and are mainly funded by *Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft* (DFG). As an academic research project the target of STORMA is to generate knowledge that can be published on a high-ranking international level. To improve and extend the collaboration with Indonesia, the DFG will sign an MoU with LIPI. The signing of the MoU will be followed by presentations of STORMA as example of research collaboration funded by DFG.

The main idea of the STORMA workshop "Global change and sustainable resource management - what can researchers tell decision makers?" is to make STORMA research more known to the public and to intensify and extend the collaboration with governmental and other institutions to use synergy effects in order to increase mutual benefit. In this line, LIPI as scientific organization has responsibility to bridge the research result from STORMA to Indonesian scientists in general.

The workshop will also provide the opportunity to figure out how our research could better address major cooperation- and development-related issues by providing valuable information for decision makers. Therefore the workshop aims at generating new research ideas and initiating more intensive collaboration between scientists, decision makers and development institutions, especially in closely working with German institutions.

Keynote speakers from STORMA will give an overview of research activities from the past years till the present, while other keynote speakers will introduce aspects of other ongoing research to open the door for discussion panels. From participating members of governmental institutions we expect to learn what are the major topics they are recently working on and where STORMA research could potentially contribute.

A poster exhibition will give the opportunity for visual presentation to all not having the chance for oral presentation during the workshop. In addition all contributions will be published in the workshop proceedings.
