The articles address issues such as sustainable land management and climate protection as well as aspects of company law. Furthermore, the Common European Agricultural Policy and

sustainability issues under WTO law will be examined. In addition, economic perspectives within the framework of insurance cover and risk management will be pointed out. Finally, the volume ends with a contribution focussing on one of the main functions of agricultural activity, food safety.
