#### The Faculty of Economic Sciences

The Faculty of Economic Sciences is the third largest of the 13 Faculties of the University of Göttingen – an internationally renowned research university with an emphasis on research-based teaching. In 2007 the University of Göttingen achieved success with its institutional strategy "Göttingen. Tradition – Innovation – Autonomy" in the Excellence Initiative by the German Federal and State governments.



Ever since its foundation in 1737 the Georg-August-Universität has educated students in the fields of economic sciences. Today the Faculty of Economic Sciences is one of the largest of its kind in Germany. 28 professors and around 100 academic staff instruct about 3200 students enrolled at the Faculty. Our full-time academic staff is supported by honorary professors and adjunct lecturers, especially in teaching.

#### The Faculty of Economic Sciences

The Faculty of Economic Sciences at Georg-August-Universität Göttingen was one of the first German universities to completely restructure its single-tier diploma programmes into a two-tiered Bachelor's and Master's system, starting in the winter semester of 2005/2006. The programmes fulfil the requirements for international recognition of the acquired degree and secure a high standard of education. The programme structures, programme contents, teaching and learning methods of the Faculty are innovative and goal-oriented with small groups, project and practical seminars as well as research-oriented offers, especially in the Master's programmes. The Faculty of Economic Sciences is renowned for offering a large variety of



specialisations in research and teaching: Business Administration (including Business Information Systems), Economics, Business and Human Resource Education as well as Economic and Social History – all complemented by the empirical subjects of Statistics and Econometrics. Our research and teaching opportunities are enriched by collaborations with researchers in the neighbouring disciplines of Agricultural Economics, Forest Economics, Social and Economic Psychology, and Economic Geography.

#### Strengths in Research

Research conducted at the Faculty of Economic Sciences in its core subjects – Business Administration and Economics – focuses on research in "Governance", "Integration and Development", and "Marketing and Channel Management". Cross-sectional areas are Business Information Systems, Business and Human Resource Education, Economic and Social History as well as the area of Statistics and Econometrics.

In addition to the various international partnerships maintained in the area of research, many externallyfunded research projects have been procured in recent years.

Researchers of the Faculty of Economic Sciences are involved in the new decision-making structures of the University as a result of the Institutional Strategy ("Zukunftskonzept") that succeeded in the Excellence Initiative, including the Göttingen Research Council (GRC) and University Research Committee.

The Faculty also offers structured doctoral programmes that greatly contribute to its research profile. Doctoral studies are conducted interdisciplinarily with other Faculties (Faculty of Agricultural Sciences, Faculty of Forest Sciences and Forest Ecology, Faculty of Law, and the Faculty of Social Sciences) and are combined in the Göttingen Graduate School of Social Sciences (GGG).

### Research Centres

The Faculty currently has two interdisciplinary research centres: The Centre for European, Governance, and Economic Development Research (cege) and the Courant Research Centre "Poverty, Equity and Growth in Developing and Transition Countries" that was founded during the Excellence Initiative.
