APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Nomination	Partner Universities must send the students' nominations through the Unisi Nomination Form. The Incoming Mobility Team will provide the partner Universities with the link to the nomination form. Nomination deadline: May 31st (for 1st semester students) October 31st (for 2nd semester students)
Application Form	Once the nomination has been checked and accepted, students will receive an <i>access code</i> and a web link to register with our Virtual Office (Segreteira online) and will then be able to enter and upload all required information to complete their application. Students do not have to register on "Segreteria online" before receiving the access code! After completing the application form, exchange students will receive an acceptance mail and practical information.
	Please note: The Incoming Mobility Team will only send acceptance letters to non EU students for visa arrangements. How to submit the online application form: https://en.unisi.it/international/international-exchange-students/prior-arrival June 30th (for first semester students)
Application Deadline	November 30th (for second semester students)
Unisipass	During the application process students will receive their Unisipass: a username and a password which allows them to login into the Virtual Office (Segreteria online).
