



Student assistant vacancies for the development of a virtual course on research ethics

The Chairs of Development Economics on behalf of the Master Programme in Development Economics are looking for three student assistants to support the development of a virtual course on ethics and security in field research.

The course will bring together perspectives of experts from different fields of study and countries. The input in forms of lectures, interviews, discussions, reports shall be prepared and edited digitally and combined with e-learning tools in order to set up the virtual course.

The three student assistants will support the Post-Doc and PhD students responsible for the course during the whole process of developing it, including search for material, communication with experts, editing videos and preparing e-learning tools. The different tasks can be split among the student assistants according to their qualifications. It is therefore not necessary to have experience in all the tasks. We encourage students of all subjects interested in ethical questions regarding primary data collection in the global south to apply.
