NOMINATIONS FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2021/2022

Nomination deadlines:

Winter Semester : May 15th, 2021

Full Year Exchange : May 15th, 2021

Spring Semester: October 15th, 2021

In case that the Erasmus+ outgoing student's selection period in your University is different from the ones listed above, please let us know **before the end of the deadlines**.

Nomination:

Partner Universities must send by email the attached **Nomination Form** to: **erasmus@uoa.gr**

Nominations must comply with the **terms of each Erasmus agreement** with regard to the **area of studies**, **level of studies** and **number of students**. For any possible change to the above areas you have to ask for our approval beforehand.

Nominated students should <u>meet our language requirements</u> (minimum requirement in Greek or in English language: Level B2) as defined in the bilateral agreements. Students that will participate in the postgraduate courses will comply with the required language level of the specific postgraduate course.

We would like to underline that **courses at the University of Athens are normally taught in Greek language**. However, there are also courses in other languages, especially at the Foreign Languages Departments, and the School of Law which offers specialized programs in English, French and German. In addition, courses in English are offered by the School of Physical Education and Sport Science, the Department of Economics, the Department of Political Science and Public Administration, the Department of Communication and Media Studies, the Department of Turkish Studies and Modern Asian Studies, the Department of Music Studies, the Department of Theology and the Department of Social Theology and the Study of Religion. In all other Departments there

are special arrangements for Erasmus+ students. The most common one is the assignment of essays in English with the use of English bibliography.

A significant number of postgraduate courses are offered in English and some in other languages (French, German, Spanish, Italian).

APPLICATION PROCEDURE FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2021/2022

Application deadlines:

The deadlines for completion of the online application form and the submission of all required documents are:

Winter Semester: April 15th, 2021 to June 15th, 2021

Full Year Exchange: April 15th, 2021 to June 15th, 2021

Spring Semester: September 15th, 2021 to November 15th, 2021

Application Form:

Once we have received the nominations from the Home University Erasmus Office, our Department will send your students the relevant link to the online application form along with all related information.

Required documents:

The nominated students must submit online the following documents:

- 1. Application Form
- 2. Learning Agreement approved by both Home and Host University. (Since January 2021 NKUA uses the OLA, therefore the incoming students are welcome to use this platform for the completion and submission of their Learning Agreements).
- 3. A readable copy of their valid passport or ID
- 4. A copy of their valid European Health Insurance Card (or of a Private Health Insurance Contract, for students of non EU countries)
- 5. A copy of their current Transcript of Records

Please, ensure that your students meet these deadlines. The processing of applications will only take place if all the above documents have been received within the time limits specified.

Within 4 weeks after the submission of the required documents, the formal **Acceptance Letter** will be sent to the student.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR

The academic year at the NKUA runs from the end of September to the beginning of July. During the summer months indicative dates for the academic year 2021-22 will be announced. However, the dates will not change significantly from the 2020-21 dates (http://en.interel.uoa.gr/erasmus/erasmus-student-mobility/academic-calendar.html).

Please note that students who have attended courses for the first semester and wish to attend the second semester's courses must register again and they have to **pay the tuition fees on their own**.
