 - A copy of TOEFL scores of 79 (iBT) and/or IELTS scores of 6.5
 - A copy of passport
 - 4 copies of 1.5-inch recent photos
- Send an e-mail to the Office about the arrival flight schedule
- Make a confirmation of housing arrangements
- Take an acceptance letter issued by the Center to apply for α NON-IMMIGRANT VISA at the Thai Embassy or Consulate-General in your country. Please be noted that the non-immigrant visa is valid for only 90 days.

- Visit the Center for International Affairs at the Meeting Room 60th Year 1, 4th Floor, Thammasat Business School Building
- Meet "Mrs. Pam" at the Center to complete the course registration forms and submit a copy of passport
- Check confirmation of the registered courses via e-mail

- Purchas textbooks and university uniforms required available at TU Bookstore (opposite of Faculty of Liberal Arts).

 *Please note that you are required to register the minimum of 3 courses with the BE Program. It is strongly recommended that pre-registration via e-mail to secure your seat be completed prior to your arrival.

- ATTENDANCE: No mandatory but if you register courses at Thammasat Business School, the class attendance is MANDATORY, no less than 70% per class.
- PARTICIPATION: Class participation is part of a student's final grade in most courses
- REGISTRATION: The exchange students are allowed to take any undergraduate courses across Thammasat Business School, Faculty of Political Science, Pridi Banomyong International College and Faculty of Liberty Arts, provided that they meet the pre-requisites, and seats are available. The exchange students are required to register at least half of the courses listed under B.E. course offering list from total courses registered.

ACCOMMODATION

Thammasat University does not provide on-campus dormitories for exchange students, but we could suggest a list of private apartments located nearby the campus. We can reserve apartments on your behalf before your arrival. The rate is approximately 5,000 – 10,000 Baht per month and 10,000 – 11,000 Baht for deposit. Each apartment is furnished with a bed, a closet, a desk and a chair, a mirror and a telephone. Towels, pillows and pillowcases, bed sheets and blankets are not included. Rooms are equipped with electrical outlets for radios and televisions, and there is enough room for a small rental refrigerator. 



HEALTH CARE

DRESS CODE

All exchange students are required to wear the Thammasat student uniform to take the quizzes and exams (both midterm & final exams). Moreover, the exchange students participating in any university activities, such as orientations and field trips, are required to wear the Thammasat students uniform.

STUDENT SERVICES

Buddy System: The International Affairs Office & BE program will promote a buddy system among the BE students to help welcome, if not accommodate, the incoming exchange students. The BE buddies will be in touch with the exchange students prior to or upon their arrival in Bangkok. 2. Puey Ungphakorn Library (Faculty of Economics Library):

The Library is located on the 3rd floor of the Faculty of Economics Building. The Puey Ungphakorn Library is the best economics collection in Thailand and one of the best in Southeast Asia. It has 80,000 books, 6,000 current journals, and 13,000 unpublished works. In addition, the library has collections of government documents and publications from universities and leading research institutions in Thailand and abroad. All graduate theses written at the Faculty can be found in the library collection. The library also offers computerized information search and facilitates inter-library loans from ESCAP, UNESCO, ILO libraries, and others.

COMPUTER LAB:

The Faculty of Economics Computer Center is located on the 4th Floor near the new economics wing. The computer center offers students and academic staff electronic equipment to handle research tasks. An integrated network provides ready access to international communications networks and satellite transmissions as well as software products. Equipment includes multi-media CD-ROM systems, scanners, DOS /Windows, Apple, UNIX-based machines and a variety of printers. The network is accessible online throughout the faculty, as well as off-site through modem connection.

First-time users are required to contact the lab staff to sign up for a login name and password. Exchange students have unlimited access to the internet. However, <u>Food and drink are not allowed in the lab.</u> Hours of Operation:

Public Access Center (PAC) Located in the applied computer laboratory, the Faculty of Liberal Arts building, 2nd floor, the facility occupies a total area of 500 sq. meters equipped with three computerized classrooms with screen projectors and audio systems to facilitate demonstrations or hands-on training. These rooms are open for students' general use when no class is scheduled.

You are also able to use computers in the computer room on the U2 floor of the main library and in the room below the cafeteria.

WI-FI INTERNET:

Economics students are also able to bring their own laptops and use them at the Wi-Fi spot around the Economics Building as indicated by the Wi-Fi sign. Students will receive the username & password for a Wi-Fi connection from the International Affairs Coordinator.

THAMMASAT UNIVERSITY BOOK STORE:

TU bookstore is stocked with publications and magazines from domestic and foreign publishers. Each semester the bookstore will have the full collection of required textbooks and learning materials for students. Prices are sometimes discounted at the beginning of the semester. It is opposite of the Faculty of Liberal Arts and next to the Multi-purpose 1 Building, next to the Tha Prachan entrance.

VISA

When incoming exchange students' visa is nearly expired (around 3 weeks), it requires to be extended by which the International Affairs coordinator will help facilitate the entire process at the Immigration Bureau.

- Required documents include:
 - 1. A testimonial from the Economics Dean
 - 2. A completed application for visa extension of temporary stay in the Kingdom (TM.7) with one 2-inch recent photo attached
 - 3. 1,900 Baht fee
 - 4. A copy of passport

Notes: Transportation will be provided for visa extension purpose.

*** If students would like to leave Thailand during their stay, they must apply for a re-entry permit before leaving the country. A re-entry permit allows them to re-enter the Kingdom of Thailand and stay for the remaining validity of the visa.

If students do not apply for re-entry, the visa will be automatically cancelled, albeit its expiry date.

- Re-entry Permit Requirements:
 - 1. Completed TM.8 Application Form
 - 2. One recent 2-inch photo
 - 3. 1,000 Baht fee / single re-entry or 3,800 Baht fee / multiple re-entry
 - 4. A copy of passport

Notes: If students study for one year. You have to report to the Immigration Office every ninety days. If you do not report to the immigration office, you have to pay the fine of 2,000 Baht.
