Application Form	Once the nomination has been checked and accepted, students will receive an access code and a web link to register with our Virtual Office (Segreteira online) and will then be able to enter and upload all required information to complete their application. Students do not have to register on "Segreteria online" before receiving the access code! After completing the application form, exchange students will receive an acceptance mail and practical information. Please note: The Incoming Mobility Team will only send acceptance letters to non EU students for visa arrangements. Learning Agreement

Before the mobility

- European students must fill out the learning agreement on the OLA platform (online learning agreement) and write the name and email address of the Unisi exchange coordinator on the section "Receiving Responsible Person".
- Non-European students or European students not enabled on the OLA platform must fill out the Learning Agreement template available at this link and send it by email as a pdf document to the USiena Exchange Coordinator.

Deadlines:

- From July 1st to September 15th, 2025 (for first semester students)
- From December 1st 2025to February 15th, 2026 (for second semester students)

Incoming Exchange students are allowed to choose courses from different departments and from different degrees.
