Call for applications for admission into the doctoral degree programme “Public International Law: Human Rights – International Economic and Environmental Law – International Criminal Law” of the University of Göttingen for 2018

The call for applications of the Faculty of Law of the University of Göttingen for admission into the doctoral degree programme “Public International Law: Human Rights – International Economic and Environmental Law – International Criminal Law” is now open for the next term in 2018.

Building on its traditional strength and profile and to further promote internationalisation, the Faculty of Law of the University of Göttingen in Cooperation with the Institute of International and European Law has established the doctoral programme in International Law. This Ph.D. programme shall provide outstanding graduates in this field the opportunity to write their dissertation with the advice of at least two of the supervisors, namely Prof. Dr. Kai Ambos, Prof. Dr. Andreas L. Paulus and Prof. Dr. Peter-Tobias Stoll. Furthermore, the three-year lasting programme includes classes in the different areas of international law as well as a variety of courses organized by the Göttingen Graduate School of Social Sciences (<http://www.uni-goettingen.de/en/29938.html>) to receive an additional training.

Deadline for application is **March, 30th 2018**.

Entry requirements of the Faculty:

1. A successfully completed university degree in accordance with § 2 (2) of the Degree Regulations for the doctoral programme “Public International Law: Human Rights – International Economic and Environmental Law – International Criminal Law” [the Degree Regulations];
2. Satisfactory English skills in accordance with § 2 (3) of the Degree Regulations;
3. Written confirmation of supervision by two members of the programme committee, based upon a research proposal produced by the candidate and an interview with at least one of these two members of the programme committee;
4. Recommendation of the programme committee.

To fulfill the requirements, please **apply** via submission of the following documents in a PDF format:

- an up-to-date CV;
- a personal statement explaining your achievements and interest in the programme (1-2 pages, typewritten in English);
- certified copies of diplomas and transcripts in accordance with § 2 (2) of the Degree Regulations (accompanied by an English translation if necessary);
- a proof of satisfactory English skills in accordance with § 2 (3) of the Degree Regulations;
- a research proposal (10-15 pages, typewritten in English);
- a list of publications (if available);
- other relevant documents and certificates, which support the application (if available).

After careful consideration, you will receive the decision from our programme committee in due course. However, please note that the eventual acceptance of your application is not connected with a scholarship from the university.
