

#### **BAMF** Registration - (Federal Office for Migration and Refugees)

If you are studying at a European university but are a national of a country outside the EU and EEA, The following documents are needed:

- Residence title of the EU country in which you are studying. The residence title must be issued for study purposes
- Passport or ID
- Proof of financial means showing that you have at least € 934 per month to support yourself (e.g. copy of bank statement, scholarship, or letter from parents – please get in touch first)
- Proof of insurance: If you do not have a "blue European health insurance card" (EHIC), you must take out statutory health insurance here in Germany.
- Home address and your address in Göttingen, if you already have one
- Complete address of your home university.

# Health Insurance – essential for your enrollment

#### **Students within the EU**

Proof of health insurance is needed – do you have EHIC? If so, you are covered for your exchange semester in Göttingen and you do not need another insurance.

Please send your EHIC card (back and front) to a German statutory health insurance company to have it checked and ask for a e-message to the university of Goettingen.

#### **Students outside of the EU**

Contract with a german statutory health insurance is strongly suggested to avoid any delay or problem
