Arjun Appadurai is Goddard Professor of Media, Culture and Communication at New York University. Trained in social and cultural anthropology, Appadurai has touched on an array of themes and issues in the course of his research that open up an innovative field of questions within cultural theory. A prolific writer, he has published broadly on questions of modernity lodged between globalization and postcolonialism, media and urbanism, including the two volumes *Modernity at Large* (1996) and *Fear of Small Numbers* (2006). He is the cofounder of the journal *Public Culture*, published since 1988.

The ZTMK's one day workshop is directed particularly at doctoral students and postdocs, but naturally also other interested parties. It provides an opportunity to speak with an influential thinker of our time in a semi-structured format. Brief excerpts of Arjun Appadurai's work are made available to all registered participants and on the ZTMK homepage. These are meant to be read by all participants so as to facilitate an informed and lively discussion. Each thematic block will be initiated by brief summary inputs and questions and then open into conversations with our featured thinker. In the course of the day we hope to jointly explore the thematic contours and intellectual range of our guest's work.
