All courses are exclusively in French except for 6 courses in English in the Political Science Master's programme.				
	The Poitiers Faculty of Law also offers a few <b>courses in Blended Mobility</b> format. When enrolling in one of these blended courses, students follow the course online and must come to Poitiers for a short one-week mobility at some time during the semester.
