## Understanding the Mystery of Academic Writing in globalized scientific communities

In this intercultural virtual exchange project with only 25 students from three different universities and study programmes, you can strengthen your academic writing skills and your intercultural competence by working collaboratively on one of the <u>ENLIGHT</u> challenges<sup>1</sup>. In small intercultural working groups, you can bring to the project the perspective of the discipline you study and enable therefore a broad interdisciplinary discussion.

As a group, you will work together and get the assignment to write an academic text genre of your choice. In the meantime, you will take part in virtual workshops on various topics, such as intercultural teamwork, text feedback, academic writing and academic writing traditions as well as the online learning platform.

The project offers you the opportunity to engage in an intercultural learning experience, to be active in your own research project, to write collaboratively for publication and to gain authentic readers. By participating in the project and submitting a portfolio you can earn 4 ECTS Credits in the key competencies. Analysing styles and requirements of scientific language in an interdisciplinary, intercultural an international context. Avoiding plagiarism.
