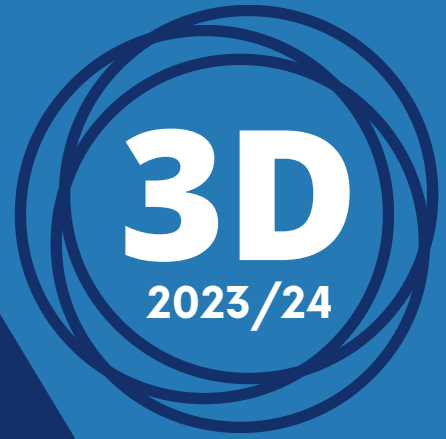


# DIGITAL DEVELOPMENT DIALOGUE
