<b>Module No.: B.WIWI.BWL.0082</b>  <b>Title:</b> Seminar in Corporate Valuation	<b>Credits: 6</b>
<b>Course Content:</b>  <u><b>Learning goals:</b></u> In this course, students deal with basic theoretical and practical problems in corporate valuation based on capital market models. After an introduction into the topic, students work for themselves on theoretical or practical problems in the field of corporate valuation. They are expected to prove their knowledge by writing a thesis as well as presenting and critically discussing their results.  <u><b>Exam requirements:</b></u> Students are expected to prove their knowledge of scientific methods by writing a thesis (8 pages) as well as presenting their results in groups (60 minutes) and actively participating in class.	<b>Course Type:</b>  Seminar
