Important to know (partner & students):	For students who are studying at a European university but are a national of a country outside the EU and EEA, we are obliged to register you with the Federal Office for Migration and Refugees (BAMF). Therefore, we need the following documents 6 weeks before you come to Göttingen.
	 Residence title of the EU country in which you are studying. The residence title must be issued for study purposes Passport or ID Proof of financial means showing that you have at least € 934 per month to support yourself (e.g. copy of bank statement, scholarship, or letter from parents Proof of health insurance (EHIC card, otherwise a German statutory health insurance is strongly suggested) Home address and your address in Göttingen, if you already have one Complete address of your home university
	After the approval of the BAMF, there is no need to apply for a visa for study purposes in Germany.
