### Staff mobility for teaching from the Georg-August-Universität Göttingen (UGOE), Germany to the University of Iringa (UoI), Tanzania

#### General overview:

The Georg-August-Universität Göttingen (UGOE) offers in the field of **Anthropology and Social and Behavioral Sciences**:

- 1x Staff mobility for teaching (from UGOE to UoI) with a duration of **up to 14 days**.

For teaching staff: A minimum of 8 hours of teaching per week at the host university has to be respected. Staff applicants should apply for the scholarship with an invitation letter from a potential supervisor of the Host University.
