Each presentation should be no longer than 20 minutes with 20 minutes of discussion afterwards. The idea is to provide you with a protected space to present everything ranging from early ideas up to rehearsing fully developed presentations for upcoming conferences or job market talks. Presenters should announce at the beginning of their talk, whether they allow questions during their talk or prefer a Q&A session afterwards.

If you have signed up as a **presenter**, please e-mail your abstract the latest on **Wednesday before the seminar** to <u>sebastian.schmidt@uni-goettingen.de</u>, so that I can circulate the program for the upcoming seminar on Thursday.

Attending the seminar regularly is compulsory for the Chair's master thesis students, PhD students, and postdocs. The Chair's visiting researchers are invited to attend. You can sign up for your preferred date using the schedule in our Teams channel. PhD students should present at least once every semester.

Master students writing their thesis at our Chair are asked to present once in the seminar, to obtain feedback on the progress of their thesis (the presentation is NOT graded and has the sole goal to improve the student's research). Master students have to attend the seminar at least once before they are eligible to present. Supervisors are responsible for scheduling a presentation date.

We will also have limited time for you to seek feedback on a specific issue (e.g., a regression specification, a STATA problem). If you are interested in the group's feedback, feel free to bring one slide with the question/problem/discussion point without prior registration.
