On 22 June 2016, Laura Teuber defended her Ph.D. thesis "Evaluation of particle and fibre degradation during processing of wood plastic composites (WPC) using dynamic image analysis". Best Paper Award

Dr. Simon Trang received the Florenz Sartorius-Prize for his thesis entitled "Adoption, Value Co-Creation, and Governance of Inter-Organizational Information Technology in Wood Networks" at the graduation ceremony of the faculty of economic sciences on 4 May 2016. Once a year this prize is awarded for an outstanding doctoral thesis in the fields of business administration, information systems, and business education.
