There is a vacancy advertised as lecturer for special duties at the Center of Methods in Social Sciences at the University of Goettingen.

News from the International Office

ERASMUS Teaching Staff Mobility enables Academic Staff (University lecturer, lecturer for special duties, research associates of the University of Goettingen) to spend a teaching period usually between 1-2 weeks (up to a maximum of 6 weeks) at European Partner Universities. Staff Mobility encourages higher education institutions to broaden and enrich the range and content of courses they offer. It allows students who do not have the possibility to participate in a mobility scheme, to benefit from the knowledge and expertise of academic staff from higher education institutions. Furthermore it promotes exchange of expertise and experience pedagogical methods, creates links between higher education institutions and motivates staff to become mobile and assists them in preparing a mobility period. If you take part in the ERASMUS Mobility Program you can request partly reimbursement for costs Furthermore all doctoral students run the chance studying abroad for 3-12 months at one of the partner universities of the Faculty of Social Sciences within the ERASMUS Student Mobility Program.
