Events of GGG: Save the Date: Week of Methods 2018 (23. -26.07.2018) GGG's 13th Interdisciplinary Week of Methods will take place from

23. – 26.07.2018, at the Convention Center by the Observatory. This year we will offer four workshops which you can choose from:

- Workshop 1: The Epistemology and Methodologies of Comparative Constitutional Law (Prof. Dr. Ran Hirschl, Toronto, Göttingen)
- Workshop 2: Mixed Methods: Methodology and Research Design (in German) (Dr. Andrea Hense, SOFI Göttingen)
- Workshop 3: Introduction to Multilevel Analysis (Dr. Carl Berning, Mainz)
- Workshop 4: Reflexive Grounded Theory Introduction and Research Lab (in German) (Prof. Dr. Franz Breuer, Münster)

The Week of Methods traditionally begins with a keynote on Monday: Prof. Dr. Paul Hoyningen-Huene (Leibniz Universität Hannover, Universität Zürich) will talk about "The Human Sciences between Quantification, Hermeneutics, and the Use of Models". Events with the participation of GGG: Study Day "Anti-Discrimination" on 19. and 20.04.2018

The study day on "Anti-Discrimination" is part of the series "All Equally Different?' Diversity in Theory and Practice". On the first day, 19.04.2018 participants in a round table working in the field of anti-discrimination will give an account of their career and every day work. On the second day, a variety of workshops will be offered, e.g. on hate speech on the internet or anti-discrimination in counseling, and a discussion about experience with nondiscriminatory language will be held. The day will conclude with an anti-discrimination-slam.
