WHAT IS THE eLADE?

Elade is a bi-level exam on-line for the accreditation of mastery of level B1/B2 in Spanish.

WHO IS IT RECOGNISED BY?

eLADE is recognised by the University of Granada, ACLES (the Spanish Association of Language Centres in Higher Education), <u>CERCLES</u> (European Confederation of Language Centres in Higher Education) and <u>CRUE</u> (the Conferation of Spanish University Deans).

WHO IS THIS EXAM INTENDED FOR?

The exam is intended for everyone who wishes to attain accreditation of levels B1 and B2 in Spanish.

WHAT IS eLADE VALID FOR?

The accreditation of these levels is valid for professional and academic purposes, as well as for access to university degree, postgraduate and Master's degree courses, and for mobility programmes in universities and centres which recognise it.

WHERE CAN THE EXAM BE TAKEN?

The exam is done on-line, and the speaking test is done on Skype. It can be done anywhere in the world, through accredited sites, or at the University of Granada's Centro de Lenguas Modernas.

WHICH INSTITUTIONS CAN HOLD eLADE?

The exam can be held at any official institution that has been accredited for this purpose. The administration centre must be an educational establishment - secondary school, high school, university faculty, college of further education, or language school - or an administrative centre - embassy, consulate, or vice-chancellory etc.

The centre must provide an exam administrator who can speak Spanish, English, French or German and who will liaise on behalf of the accredited centre with the eLADE examiners.

TYPES OF CERTIFIED TEST EXAMINATION SITES

- Occasional Examination Site. Valid for a particular exam call, usually upon request by an individual student or a group of them. In this case, a confidentiality agreement is required, according to the conditions described in this link: <u>http://bit.ly/29RV7Fh</u>
- **Permanent Examination Site**. By means of a binding and permanent agreement requested by the applicant Examination Site. The Examination Site will receive 20% of each candidate's examination fees.
