**Notes on the application documents and the admission procedure:**

- **The deadline for submitting the application for admission and the associated documents is 15 January 2023.**
  - Admission has provisional status until all documents have been received by the Dean's Office of the Faculty of Chemistry. Documents submitted late will result in final exclusion from the admission procedure.
  - The following deadlines apply: Proof of sufficient German or English language skills can be submitted until 15 May 2023. Final certificates can be submitted until 30 September 2023.
  - If you are already studying or have studied in a closely related degree programme, an examination is required to determine whether you are still eligible for admission to the Göttingen Master's Programme in Chemistry.
  - Language certificates: Please note that we can only accept the types of evidence specified in the regulations on admission and admission to the degree programme.
  - eAssessment as supplementary proof of the relevance of the previous studies: The eAssessment is carried out for the first time in this admission round. In addition to the submission of other documents, the following groups of persons must provide evidence of the eAssessment:
    - by foreign nationals and stateless persons with a recognised previous education certificate who are neither equivalent to Germans according to legal regulations nor nationals of another member state of the European Union or another contracting state of the Agreement on the European Economic Area nor have acquired their Bachelor's degree or an equivalent degree at a German higher education institution or at a higher education institution of another member state of the European Union or another contracting state of the Agreement on the European Economic Area.
  - If the university is unable to provide information on the conversion of credits into ECTS credits, please send us module descriptions of the modules you have taken, including information on the number of hours you have spent studying (self-study and attendance study).
