



Vacancy for one student assistant

Arthropods constitute most of the global biodiversity and provide key ecosystem services. In agricultural landscapes, arthropod natural enemies, such as beetles and spiders, are critical regulators of pest populations. Within the KOOOPERATIV project (www.uni-goettingen.de/kooperativ/project), we collected ground-dwelling arthropods from wheat fields along a landscape diversity gradient.

We are looking for one student assistant (f/m/d) to sort and identify collected arthropods.

Tasks: After initial training, sorting of arthropod samples, counting and identification of ground beetles (Carabidae) and data entry (flexible hours).

Opportunities: You will learn to identify arthropods to order and family level and gain experience in lab work with arthropod samples.

Requirements: Previous taxonomical knowledge of arthropods is desirable but not mandatory.

Time period: The start date can be negotiated. Ideally, February or March 2023.
