· Organize democratic meetings:

They are at the center of SSE. Once you have a community, discuss what makes meetings democratic and effective.

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COMMUNITY BUILDING

To ensure healthy development, sustainability and resilience of a social and solidarity economy (SSE) enterprise it has to be supported by building a community around it. Building a community creates lasting bonds between members and ensures the commitment needed to develop an economic model that is based on people's needs and a common good. In SSE, it is the people, their skills and knowledge, that are at the centre.

- Learn to work together. A community is processual
 and continually in flux. Foster the ability of everyone to
 articulate their views, attitudes, and needs and create
 procedures to address conflict and disagreement.
- Know your Community. Find out who are the people in and around your community and choose the best ways to approach them.
- Reach out. Besides working on communication and relations within the community remember to reach out for new members and look for alliances among other social actors and relevant movements.

CO-OPERATIVES

A co-operative (co-op) is an autonomous association of persons united voluntarily to meet their common economic, social, and cultural needs and aspirations through a jointly-owned and democratically-controlled enterprise. The co-operative movement is an important part of social and solidarity economy (SSE).

- Democratic decision-making and ownership.
 All decisions in co-ops are taken democratically by their members. Primary members have equal voting rights one member has one vote. Members also democratically control the capital of the co-op.
- Cooperation as a means of relating to the world. Co-ops are cooperating with other co-ops or other SSE initiatives and organisations and participate in building the co-operative movement, support their local community and respect non-human nature.

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FOOD SOVEREIGNTY

Food Sovereignty aims to transform the entire food system: from socially and environmentally destructive to a regenerative one - employing resilient agricultural practices and respect to nature and all people.

- Easy ways to join the movement:

 Become local Choose from plentiful varieties on a local market rather than uniform industrial production in supermarkets.
- Become a gardener on your own, in an allotment garden, or a community garden. Or get inspired by guerilla gardeners and look for a forgotten spot in the city!
- · Become part of a local Community Supported Agriculture group (or start one)!
- · Join (or start) a food co-operative distribute healthy and sustainable food.
- Be part of a policy change promote Food Sovereignty values!

Promoting Employability through Social Solidarity Economy

- Implement and promote the framework of Social Solidarity Economy (SSE) in Vocational and Educational Training (VET)
- comprehensive training and professional development of younger generations, which integrates alternative socioeconomic models in their framework of ideas and attitudes
 - VET Trainer's Guide on SSE (skills, competences, knowledge, learning outcomes).
 It will introduce the SSE occupational area to VET system by developing a particular toolkit needed to VET trainers.
 - A common package on VET training modules for the inclusion of SSE. The modules will offer increased knowledge and innovative methodologies in order to deliver more comprehensive and inclusive curricula.
 - An advocacy paper for the inclusion of these VET training modules in VET curricula at national and European level.
