**Staff mobility for teaching or training  
from Hebrew University of Jerusalem (HUJI), Israel  
to the Georg-August-Universität Göttingen (UGOE), Germany**

#### General overview:

The Georg-August-Universität Göttingen (UGOE) offers in **all fields**:

- **1 Staff mobility** for teaching (from HUJI to UGOE) with a duration of **5 days** (excluding travel days) each.
- The mobilities must be completed by 31.07.2023.

For teaching staff: A minimum of 8 hours of teaching per week at the host university has to be respected. Staff applicants should apply for the scholarship with an invitation letter from a potential supervisor of the Host University.

All grant holders are insured by a central Group Insurance, which will be centrally organised by the Project Coordination Team upon successful nomination. The insurance costs (approximately 0,90 EUR per day) are deducted from the individual support.
