Programme overview

The programme is designed to foster scientific exchange, collaboration, and innovation in the field of land use and resilience. The programme supports established researchers who wish to spend 1-2 months at the University of Göttingen within the framework of the Competence Center Landscape Resilience (ClaRe), expanding their network, sharing expertise, and advancing joint research activities. The 1-2 months research stay is to be taken within 12 months of approval.

What We Offer

- **Financial Support:** €3,000 per month to cover travel, accommodation, and research expenses.
- **Networking:** Opportunities to connect with leading experts in the field of land use and resilience.
- **Visibility:** Present 1–2 lectures/seminars at the host institution.
- **Research Collaboration:** Work on joint methods, initiate or advance collaborative projects, and co-author a scientific paper.
- **Professional Development:** Enhance your scientific profile and broaden your methodological repertoire.

Please submit a **1-page proposal using the template** that includes:

- **Institution & Contact**
- **Planned Activities:** (e.g., lectures, methods exchange, research collaboration)
- **Expected Output:** (e.g., joint paper, new methods, network expansion)
- **Timeline:** Indicate preferred dates (must take place within 12 months of approval)

Selection Criteria

- Scientific quality and feasibility of the proposed activities
- Potential for long-term collaboration and impact
- Contribution to the applicant's and UGOE's research environment
