WHAT TO BRING	
	Towels and facecloth ⁵
	Clothes ¹
	Shoes and socks
	Toiletries, including toothpaste, soap, toothbrush, shampoo, etc. ⁵
	Laundry detergent for washing your clothes ⁵
	Laundry basket ⁵
	Your computer, mobile phone and appropriate/approved powerboard
	Surge protector/approved voltage converter ²
	Cooking utensils – pots, pans, cutlery, plate, cup/glass ⁵
	Food ⁵
	Small containers/zip lock bags to store your food in the fridge/freezer ⁵
	Linen – pillowcase, bed sheet, blanket ³
	Earplugs
	Hair dryer ⁴
	Emergency contacts/list of important phone numbers
	Prescribed medication
WHAT NOT TO BRING	
	Large Stereos
	Pets
	Illegal drugs of any kind
	Any sort of weapon
	Candles or unauthorized lanterns
	Unauthorized electrical appliances
	Furniture of any kind, unless prior approval is sought
WHAT IS PROVIDED BY THE HALLS OF RESIDENCE	
	A single bed with a mattress and a pillow
	Bed sheet (x2), pillow case and a blanket upon request - linen changed weekly
	Cleaning equipment: Broom, waste bin, bucket
	Toilet Paper
	Window curtain, wardrobe, a chest of drawers and a bookshelf
	Wall/ceiling fan
	Shared kitchenette/toilet & bathroom/lounge & dining area/washing machines in 10 th and 11 th Hall
	A Study desk & a chair

**Any voltage converter/power board brought into the Halls of Residence must be approved before use. Students are responsible for their electronic items and must seek assistance before use. If electronics (computer, laptop, gadgets, hair dryer/blowers, etc.) are brought and used without proper converters, USP will not reimburse for any damages caused. The current in Fiji is 240 volts AC 50Hz with three-pin power points.*

- ¹ Don't forget to take into consideration Fiji's climate & ranging temperatures. A light sweater/pull-over is recommended.
- ² All voltage regulators/converters must be approved before use.
- ³ These are provided, however, you can bring your own if you wish.
- ⁴ Be sure that you have the right voltage before use.
