## **Requirements are:**

- PhD in agricultural science, food chemistry, veterinary medicine or alike, preferably with a focus on product quality, completed with very

- Research experience in the field of livestock science, quality of animal products, sensory analysis and/or food analysis (especially chromatography, spectroscopy)
- (Initial) experience in university teaching and thesis supervision
- Good to very good command of written and spoken English and (desirable) good to very good command of German

- Ability and willingness to perform statistical data analysis, ideally using R
