

APPLICATION PROCEDURE FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-2023

In order to undertake an exchange period at the Faculty of Law of the University of Barcelona (UB), you need to follow the steps described below:

1. Complete the online application form, available at:

https://www.ub.edu/acad/estada/sol_alumne/identificacio_2022.php?lang=3

The form can only be completed once and afterwards it cannot be modified, so it must be filled out as complete as possible. If you want to modify or cancel your application after saving your data, you must contact us by e-mail at incoming.dret@ub.edu.

2. Select your courses:

The academic offer for the academic year 2022-2023 is not available yet; for this reason, you will have to make a provisional selection of subjects with the information of the academic year 2021-2022. Please note that the language of instruction may change in 2022-2023.

- Academic workload: Students should take between 15 and 30 ECTS credits per semester.
- **Courses offer**: There are no restrictions as to the degree of the subjects you choose. You can take classes from different study areas, as long as they are offered at the Faculty of Law, and your home University approves your choices.

To see the relevant details of each course, you must click on the "TARDOR" (Fall) or "PRIMAVERA" (Spring) buttons, next to the title of the course you are interested in. The information displayed will include the class groups available, the timetable, and the language in which the class is taught (Catalan, Spanish, or English). Most courses can be taken in Spanish, although incoming students are advised to check that information before choosing a subject.

IMPORTANT! Please bear in mind that <u>international students are not allowed to enrol in groups</u> with the code "O"; therefore, you must choose groups with the codes "M" (*mañana*) or "T" (*tarde*).

For instance, the class groups M1 and M2 are taught on Tuesdays from 12 to 14h and Thursdays from 10 to 12h in Spanish (you must attend both days), while the class group M6 is taught on Thursdays from 12 to 14h and Fridays from 10 to 12h in English. The class group M3 is offered in Catalan, so it cannot be chosen unless you can prove your knowledge of the language.

3. Send the following documents by e-mail to the International Relations Office:

1. A copy of the **UB application** form that you have completed online with your selection of subjects. You must download the document and send it to us by email. It must be stamped by your university and signed by you and your exchange coordinator (please provide his/her contact details in the section "tutor", as shown below):

2. A copy of your **passport/ID card**.

3. Non-native speakers of Spanish (or Catalan) / English: **certificate of language proficiency** (at least B1 of the CEFR).

Please send all three documents in one single email to incoming.dret@ub.edu.

Application deadlines: We should receive the above mentioned documents no later than

- June 15th (for first semester or full academic year applications).
- November 15th (for second semester applications).

Once we have received all the required documents, your application will move forward to the review process. Applicants will be contacted by email when an official decision has been made on the acceptance or rejection of the application.

IMPORTANT! Please remember that it is your responsibility to ensure that all materials required for the evaluation of your application are received by our office before the deadline, and that your application is complete. **Late or incomplete applications will be rejected.**

IMPORTANT! Any changes to your initial selection of subjects should be exceptional, and will only be approved for the following reasons:

- Reasons for **deleting** a subject (or changing the class group):
 - The previously selected subject is full or no longer offered.
 - The subject is offered in a different language than previously specified in the course catalogue.

- Reasons for **adding** a subject:
 - Substituting a deleted component.
 - Adding a subject offered at another UB Faculty (you may request, upon arrival, to include subjects from other faculties, as long as there are places available and at least 51% of your overall study plan corresponds to the Faculty of Law).

IMPORTANT! Changes will only be allowed for the above reasons, even if your university has told you that you can change your program of study upon arrival in Barcelona. Therefore, it is extremely important that you **check your chosen subjects well**, paying attention to the following information:

- **Number of credits**: make sure that you meet your university's requirements concerning the number of credits you need to take.
- Academic content: read the course descriptions on the website. Look at the course syllabus, goals, materials and assessment sytem to make sure it is right for you. Also check if there are prerequisites for each course.
- **Timetable**: avoid overlapping schedules.

Please, take the time to carefully review all of this information when planning your program of study. Do not assume that you can simply change your subjects when you arrive in Barcelona.

IMPORTANT! All exchange students must have **medical**, accident and repatriation insurance, valid for the entire duration of their stay in Barcelona, otherwise they will not be allowed to enrol at the UB. If you are a citizen from the European Union, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway or Switzerland, you can also apply for a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC).
