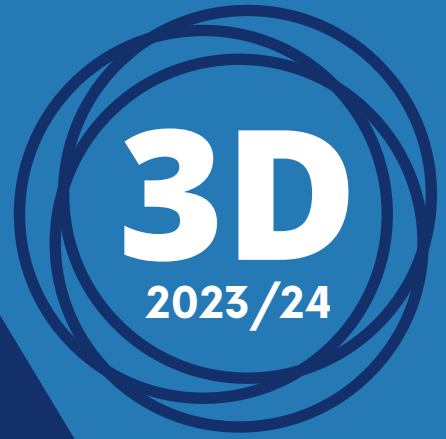


DIGITAL DEVELOPMENT DIALOGUE
