

CHECKLIST: FINDING AN ACCOMMODATION FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS



For degree-seeking students (except double degree/dual enrolment or Erasmus Mundus), PhD research stay, internship (Erasmus+ etc.) or short-term stay:

- Inform yourself on our [website](#) about accommodation options in Göttingen
- Fill out the [online-form](#) to apply for a room
Please inform the [Accommodation Service](#) in case anything changes
- [Apply](#) for a student dormitory at Studentenwerk if you are interested in this option; keep in mind that you need to show a proof of your student status for a rental contract in a dormitory
- Search for accommodation on the private market
- Inform the [Accommodation Service](#) if you have found a room; it's important to reply to any room offers you get from the Accommodation Service or Studentenwerk within 7 days, even if you are not interested
- Sign your rental contract: keep in mind that this is legally binding

- Before your arrival: get in touch with your landlord about receiving your keys or sign up for the [Buddy Service](#) ahead of time
- Ask your landlord to fill out the form “*Wohnungsgeberbestätigung*” and register as a resident at the city hall (*Einwohnermeldeamt*) within 14 days of your arrival
