Accommodation	NCU may guarantee accommodation in student's houses to those
	Erasmus+ students who finish the online application procedure by June 1
	or November 1 at the latest. (There is no separate application form for
	accommodation!)
Orientation Programme	All new international students are invited to an Orientation Programme
	organised by the International Programmes Office. The Orientation Week
	is timetabled for the beginning of the academic year in October and
	another in mid-February. It includes administrative meetings, intercultural
	workshops, a sightseeing tour around Toruń, lectures on Polish history
	and many more.
Mentor system	Each Erasmus+ student coming to NCU has his own mentor – a Polish
	student (very often a former Erasmus student) who picks up an exchange
	student from the station and helps him/her during stay in Toruń.
Erasmus Student Network (ESN)	Erasmus+ students may also look for some information and support from
	our Erasmus Student Network, which helps them adopt in Toruń more
	easily and quickly by organising together with our office various meetings
