

## Transnationalisation and Education – Roundtable Abstracts

### 11h – 12h30 Roundtable 1: Making citizens for a global world

The construction of citizens in different education contexts is increasingly challenged by globalisation processes. The roundtable focuses on two aspects: on the one hand, we will discuss the concept of (global) citizenship and its implications on education on a theoretical level. On the other hand, a reflection on a method(olog)ical level will take place on the basis of a critical perspective on the paradigm of methodological nationalism. The roundtable also considers contributions on policies and practices of (global) citizenship education in different contexts around the world which are related to theoretical and method(olog)ical issues.

### 14h00 – 15h30 Roundtable 2: Transnational education spaces between mobility and migration

Transnational education spaces can emerge from institutional practices (international curricula and diplomas, exchange programmes etc.) but also from the practices of social actors. This roundtable focuses on transnational education spaces and their emergence in the different segments of the education system. These segments are related to contrasting social valorisations which are reflected in the tension in the discourses on mobility and migration. This tension will be discussed drawing on theoretical approaches and empirical insights regarding different empirical contexts of transnational education spaces.
