

Checklist:

Applying for the Master's Programme in Chemistry at Georg-August-Universität Göttingen

The application for admission into the master's programme in chemistry is submitted in writing. The respective form and documents must be submitted by January 15th 2022 when applying for the summer semester 2022 (cut-off period!).

Please send your application for admission and the corresponding documents to:

Please use the application form to apply for admission, which must be signed personally by you. Please attach the following documents to the application:

- The applicant's bachelor's certificate(s) in the form of certified copies or certified German or English translations if the originals are not written in German or English; if the bachelor's certificate is not available yet, a certificate specifying the study achievements completed so far, the credits and the average mark is to be submitted (final certificates must be handed in by September 30th 2022).
- In case the university does not use the ECTS-system please attach a proof concerning the equivalence of the credits by the university or by another official institution
- A CV in German or English including a photograph and a meaningful summary of the applicant's education
- Proof of sufficient knowledge of the German or English language if the applicant does not have a German school leaving certificate nor a bachelor's degree or its equivalent completed at a German or English university. This proof must be a certificate issued by an accredited institution and state that the applicant's proficiency is DSH 2 level (English GER C1 level) or higher (this certificate must be handed in by May 15th 2022).
