Academic Calendar

Nomination and Application Deadlines for Exchange Students Winter term: nomination deadline April 15th, application deadline May 1st Summer term: nomination deadline October 15th, application deadline November 1st

Please nominate your students through our mobility portal: https://goettingen.moveon4.de/form/63a045ce8ac58865e67a227e/eng After nomination, the nominated students apply via our mobility portal. For this purpose, the students receive a registration link that is sent to the student's email address provided during the nomination process. The application must be completed within the application deadline.

Processing time for applications is 4 to 8 weeks.

Necessary Application Documents

A letter of motivation and transcript of records – to be uploaded during the application process of the students.

After the approval of the faculty, an information e-mail including the next steps to be taken will be sent out to the nominated students.

Language Requirements

We do not demand a proof or certificate of language proficiency. We do, however, have clear guidelines regarding the language proficiency that is required to optimize the chances for your students to study here successfully. We leave it to our partners to nominate students who meet our language requirements. Our guidelines are as follows:

If the language of instruction is English:

For students from non-English speaking countries, English language proficiency equivalent to level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages is required. A level of B1 in German is recommended.

Examples of comparable minimum scores (for your orientation):

TOEFL iBT: 79 – 93 IELTS: 6.5

If the language of instruction is German:

German language proficiency equivalent to level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages is required.

Examples of comparable minimum scores (for your orientation): Goethe BE Test DAF TDN 3

As part of the Global Exchange Programme, "Go explore - Study abroad in Göttingen" offers a selected course programme for non-German speaking international exchange students interested in focus areas of sustainability, data science and inequality/diversity. In addition to a course on Ethnic and Cultural Diversity in Germany the programme also includes a mandatory German language course. The program is designed for one semester and requires English proficiency at B2 level.

Please indicate in your nominations if students wish to apply to participate in this particular programme.
