Going abroad teaching – Places to go and ways to do it

Peer-assisted placement finding

Fach-/Forschungspraktikum für Lehramtsstudierende abroad?

Do you want to do your four-weeks teaching practice abroad and are looking for a way how to do it? As it sometimes seems difficult to find a placement, here is a list of jobs and ways to work as teaching assistants currently or recently done by teacher students of the SEP. These can serve as examples how to organize a trip abroad. If you have questions that go beyond the information material provided by the SEP, the Pädagogischer Austauschdienst, Foyer International etc. (check those first, please!) the students listed here would be ready to let you know more about how they found their placements. Please note that in some cases you need to apply up to a year in advance!

If you want to have this stay recognized as your teaching practice, you need to take the *Begleitseminar zum (im Ausland absolvierten) Forschungspraktikum (4-wöchig): Expectations and Experience of Teaching Assistants: A workshop for in-coming and out-going students.*

If you are planning on going abroad between your BA and MA, you can – and should! – take the preparatory part of this seminar already during your BA. It will be recognized for the MA in Göttingen.

Previous teaching assistants recommended to do a one-year Zusatzzertifikat Deutsch als Fremdsprache: <http://www.uni-goettingen.de/de/54102.html> . This is no prerequisite but has been considered to be very helpful.
