

How to Measure Social Sustainability of Transportation Systems

Motivation:

Sustainability is defined as the integration of economic, ecological and social matters. However, it is unclear which dimensions exactly make up the social component of transport systems' sustainability. In this thesis a literature based framework is developed, which allows a structured analysis of the social sustainability of transport systems.

Question:
