## DR. KUJANPÄÄ

Dr Katja Kujanpää (title of docent in New Testament Studies and Early Christianity) is a Core Fellow at the interdisciplinary Helsinki Collegium for Advanced Studies (University of Helsinki). In her current project, she examines how early Christian writers of the 1st and 2nd centuries construct the authority of the Jewish scriptures when seeking to strengthen and shape the group identity of their audience. She is interested in applying interdisciplinary approaches (e.g. social psychological theories, quotation studies) to the study of ancient texts. Her doctoral dissertation *The Rhetorical Functions of Scriptural Quotations in Romans* was published in Brill's *Supplements to Novum Testamentum* (2019). After her doctorate at the University of Helsinki (2018), she has made research visits to Oxford University and Australian Catholic University.
