## Research

Universidad EAFIT has consolidated itself as a teaching with Research University. It has developed an institutional system that integrates not only its academic community, but also the community in general. The basis of the system is EAFIT's Children University, which develops programs for middle school and high school students; EAFIT's undergraduate students are also involved in the research development of the University through its more than 80 Junior Research Groups, where more than 960 students participate. EAFIT's 636 Researchers are part of the 44 Research Groups.
