A Brief Presentation of BEST Exchange

- Planned outcomes during the 4 year period:
 - Joint Classrooms (for teaching students of all subjects)
 - Student Mobility from Göttingen to the partners during winter*
 - Student Mobility to Göttingen during the summer*
 - Yearly Summer School for teaching students (blended format)
 - Staff Mobility to Göttingen during the Summer School

* in the Northern Hemisphere







BEST Plans 2021

- > Unfortunately, no physical mobility for students and staff in 2021
- Fully virtual summer school (instead of blended)
- > Online staff network meetings
- Virtual formats to bring us together during summer/fall 2021
 - Joint Classrooms
 - Online buddy system for students
 - Virtual social events
- Preparation of Erasmus partnerships and physical mobility starting from fall 2022
 - > Allows students from the EU partners to come to Göttingen (not covered by the DAAD)
 - > Allows us to design a suitable program for your students who will come to Göttingen in 2022





BEST Summer Schools (2021-2024)

Under usual circumstances:

- Travel expenses + accommodation for 5 students per partner institution
- Travel expenses + accommodation for at least 1 lecturer per partner institution
- > 5 experts/guests from other institutions
- Field trips and similar program points
- ECTS and certificates will be awarded







BEST Summer School 2021

2021 virtual format:

- Fopic: Virtual Exchange
- Likely allows for more participants
- Allows for more flexibility
- Make students and staff aware of the possibilities from 2022 onwards
- ECTS and certificates will be awarded

Teacher Education at the University of Tartu

- 25 programmes in 4 faculties
- Pedagogicum as a co-ordinating body for all teacher education programmes
- Common core module (60 ECTS) at MA level:
 - General pedagogical competence (base) module (24 ECTS)
 - Practice module (24 ECTS)
 - Didactics module (12 ECTS)
- MA programme generally 2 years and 120 ECTS





- 1000 students, ca 60 members of academic staff
- In-service teacher training: 4000+ annually
- Some research topics:
 - professional development of teachers
 - educational technology
 - learning analytics
 - digital literacy
 - special education
 - inquiry-based learning
 - students' metacognition
 - Multilingual and –cultural education
- Centre of Educational Innovation



UPPSALA UNIVERSITET

Teacher Education at Uppsala University

Faculty of Educational Sciences

- Research-based education for high-school teachers
- 20 different departments engaged
- Department of Education (EDU) for didactic studies with 310 employees and 7,500 students in programs and courses.
- Teacher programs for pre-school, primary school and secondary school

The teacher program for upper secondary school

- 10 or 11 semesters of full-time studies, mostly at BA level
- Combinations of sets of two school subjects possible:

Biology, Chemistry, English, French, Geography, German, History, Mathematics, Mother tongue (Arabic and Turkish), Philosophy, Physics, Religious education, Social sciences, Spanish, Swedish, Swedish as a foreign language





The structure of the program for upper secondary school teachers

Three parts: Subject studies (yellow) Didactic studies (pink) - EDU School practice (white) - EDU

Strong research areas at EDU: Leadership in the classroom Education for children with special needs

Sociology of education

Worth knowing: International cooperation/exchange (EDU = Department of Education) (I vissa fall kan studiegången behöva anpassas utifrån hur kurserna inom ämnesstudier ges höst- respektive vårtermin.)

Teacher Education at the University of Göttingen



- ZEWIL (Central Institute for Teacher Education and Research)
- Research-based study program for high school teachers (~2.500 students, 9 faculties)
- Bachelor (6 semesters), Master (4 Semesters)
- > Almost any combination of 2 of these subjects:
- Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics, Computer Science, Geography
- German, English, French, Spanish, Chinese, Russian, Latin, Greek, Philosophy and Ethics, History
- Subject didactics > Politics, Religion, Physical Education





Teacher Education at the University of Göttingen

Our special program: Lehramt PluS

- Several different certificates to deepen knowledge on specific topics in the field of teacher education
- For example: Education for Sustainable Development, Inclusive Education or CLIL
- > 3 School Labs visited by pupils, where students can be involved
 - Y-Lab: Humanities
 - > X-Lab: Natural Sciences
 - B-Lab: Life Sciences
