What is changing?

Moving from paper-based evaluation to Online-in-Präsenz

ONLINE ...

- Questionnaires are created digitally and evaluations are carried out in Stud.IP via Internet-compatible mobile devices.


IN-PRÄSENZ ...

- Between 7-25 January 2019 students will be asked by teachers to complete the online evaluation while in class.



How does it work?

**Online-in-Präsenz evaluation
step-by-step**
For students

Step 1 – go online with your laptop, smartphone or tablet (e.g. via [eduroam](#) ), go to eCampus and log in with your access data.


Step 2 – go to Stud.IP and select the right course under “Courses”.



Step 3 – You can find the relevant online questionnaire under the evaluation symbol  or under „Lehrveranst.-Evaluation“.

N.B. – The survey can take a while to load, please be patient!

Step 4 – Complete the online survey in German or English, and send. Done!



Students can only take part in a survey once for a course!

The Online-in-Präsenz evaluation requires a private mobile device and is not yet barrier-free.

As an alternative the evaluation can be completed later on another computer using eCampus or Stud.IP access **during the evaluation period 7-25 January 2019.**

You may use the computer rooms (CIP-Pools) and computer workstations in your faculty and in the libraries.

... simplifies the organisational process,


... increases data quality,
