### Determinations of the Faculty of Chemistry Crisis Team for level 3 of the University Covid 19 Stage Plan (as of start summer semester 2021)

### For the Faculty of Chemistry, the following applies in detail:

All work that can be done in the home office should be done there. The goal is a noticeable reduction in attendance.

The responsibility for the implementation of the measures lies with the responsible head of department or the person responsible for a (teaching) event.

#### Teaching:

- Classroom teaching takes place in accordance with the resolutions passed by the university's crisis management team for lab courses with reduced presence and in compliance with the corresponding hygiene/infection protection measures.

- Lectures, exercises, seminars, etc. take place digitally, the lectures as asynchronous offerings with the possibility of interaction with the teacher, if possible.

- Research lab courses and Bachelor's and Master's theses take place in accordance with the resolutions passed by the university's crisis management team and in compliance with the corresponding hygiene/infection protection measures.

# Exams:

- Examinations take place in presence after prior approval by the university crisis staff (applications are collected via the dean's office).

- Oral examinations and disputations take place digitally.

# (Research-related) qualification work/research:

These are to be limited to projects where there is a risk of significant damage if they are abandoned.

In such cases:

- Theses, doctoral theses and postdocs: it is possible to carry out the necessary work under the safety measures described below.

#### Safety measures

- The distance and mouth-nose protection (MNS) regulations of the university apply with the following, tightening additions:

- Rooms may only be used individually (e.g. offices, coffee and social rooms, writing and computer rooms). Exception: open-plan laboratories, here one person per laboratory span is permitted, provided that the minimum distance can be maintained. If the supervision of departmental internships, Bachelor's theses, Master's theses or similar temporarily requires otherwise, the use by two persons per brace is possible in accordance with the approval of the university crisis staff. In this case, the obligation to wear an MNS must be observed.

In addition, the basic rules for occupational safety (e.g. calling distance) must be observed even in reduced operation. If necessary, headsets or video transmissions can be used to stay in contact (only voluntarily because of data protection!). Dangerous work should be avoided as far as possible.

- All work that cannot be done in the home office (central facilities, technical area, administration if necessary) will continue to be carried out on site, but under stricter safety precautions. At the moment, the university does not envisage any from work is not envisaged by the university at the moment.
