Support services provided by partner universities

No tuition fees at partner institutions



Erasmus+

Study at a European partner university

Recognition of academic achievements

Support through mobility grant

Professional & organizational support before, during & after stay



What requirements do I have to fulfil?

- possible from the 3rd BSc. Semester on
- good knowledge of the teaching language (certificate needed!)
- good academic performance
- professional & personal motivation
- observance of the funding & payment criteria




Planning & Preparation

- inform yourself about calls for applications & application criteria/procedures











The application

Application deadlines

January 31, 2025 for stays in the academic year 2025/26

→ winter semester 2025/26 and summer semester 2026

Application is divided into several phases

- Decentralized application procedure at the faculty (31.01.2025)
- Acceptance of an offer of an exchange place (offers will most likely be sent by 19.02.2025; acceptance must most likely be returned by 03.03.2025)
- Nomination by the faculty at the host university (depending on host institution and mobility semester April-June 2025)
- Application at the host university by students (respectively from April 2025 onwards)

Selection criteria

- Personal motivation 20%
- Professional motivation 30%
- Academic achievement 30%
- Fewer Opportunity 10%
- Financing 10%
- Language skills must be proven at the time of application!



Decentralized application procedure at the faculty

Application deadline: 31.01.2025

Procedure for applying to the faculty in the application portal

- Register → only valid with student email address @stud.uni-goettingen.de !!!
- 2. Fill out application form
- 3. Select 3-4 universities of your choice
- 4. Upload documents

Required documents

- Overview of academic achievements to date (current FlexNow transcript of records)
- Language certificate
- Certificate of enrolment for the current winter term





Selection procedure at the faculty

- → Selection procedure according to centrally applicable criteria
 - Personal motivation 20 %
 - Professional motivation 30 %
 - Academic achievement 30%
 - Fewer Opportunity 10 %
 - Financing 10 %

→ The offer of a study place is expected from:

19.02.2025

→ Confirmation of acceptance must be made within 14 days!

Request for pre-recognition of achievements obtained abroad via PIM

Preparation of an "Online Learning Agreement for Studies" (OLA) Online Linguistic Support (OLS language test)



Event at Göttingen International (information on document management)



Travel planning



Studies at the host university (a minimum of 10 ECTS per semester must be completed!)



Registration at host university

- Students must register according to the requirements of the host university
 - → Registration deadlines vary from university to university please double-check!!!
- You will receive all required information or links directly from the host university as soon as your nomination has been processed (sometimes this happens on the same day, sometimes weeks pass).
- Apply for a leave of absence for a semester abroad (optional, not mandatory)



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Compulsory online language tests

- Conducted before the start & after the end of the stay
- Language tests available for each country based on language of instruction at host university
- Tests are <u>NOT</u> a basis for selection & acceptance at the host university → are intended to document linguistic development
- The Göttingen International team or the EU Academy will inform you if and when you have to take an online language test

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Platform for Inter*national Student Mobility (PIM)

What is PIM?

- Newly introduced platform for the recognition of academic achievements
- Simplification of the recognition process
- Recognition database → Modules previously recognized can be viewed

Before the start of the stay abroad...

Pre-recognition on the PIM platform

- Selection of courses at the host university
- Submit a pre-recognition request via PIM
- Accepted pre-recognition requests guarantee the later recognition of study achievements completed abroad

Online Learning Agreement (OLA)

After your recognition request in PIM has been fully processed by us:

Online Learning Agreement (OLA)

- The learning agreement is part of the funding agreement
- Fill in the form, sign it yourself and have it signed by both programme coordinators (home and host university). It will automatically be forwarded to the relevant offices on the platform!
- Complete at least 10 credits per semester, some host universities require you to take more courses.

During the exchange:

Revised Learning Agreement

• Within the 1st month of mobility → submit pre-recognition request via PIM, apply changes to the OLA, sign it yourself & have it countersigned by both programme officers.

How can I finance a stay abroad?

- Two elements:
 - Waiver of tuition fees from the host university
 - Payment of a financial contribution for the stay abroad
- Scholarship rates based on country categories:
 - Country group 1: €600 per sponsored month (e.g. Scandinavian countries, France,...)
 - Country group 2: €540 per sponsored month (e.g. Greece, Slovenia,...)
 - Country group 3: €540 per sponsored month (e.g. Hungary, Poland,...)
- Additional notes:
 - Rates are reset every year
 - Students with 'fewer opportunities' can apply for additional grants
 - No funding provided for subsequent nominations & extensions



Funding

- Funding requirements:
 - Duration of stay ≠ Duration of funding
 - Study visits of up to one semester (6 months) receive max. funding for 5 months
 - Study stays of more than 2 semesters (up to 12 months) receive max. funding for 10 months
 - for shorter stays, please check the details:
 - Göttingen International (https://www.uni-goettingen.de/en/647426.html)
- Scholarship payment in 2 instalments
 - 75% of the total amount at the beginning of the stay
 - 25 % of the total amount after the end of the stay
